The consensus among users is that while Ikea's affordable options may seem practical, they were not intended to serve as aquarium stands. Therefore, it's crucial to thoroughly assess ...

I built a pine frame to go on the top because the shelf dimension was nearly identical to the tank, so I need a little more real estate. Structurally, I reinforce the sides, top, and bottom ...

Unless you plan to reinforce whatever you buy with wood or metal to make it more suitable to hold that weight, putting an aquarium full of water on top of something from IKEA isn't a good idea in the long run.

Our furniture is not designed to carry the weight of an aquarium. The filled water tank, together with filter, pump and lighting can quickly weigh up to 250 kg. 600 liters aquariums can also weigh a solid 750 kg.

I have outlined everything you should consider if you want to put a fish tank on a piece of IKEA furniture. Small tanks should not be problematic if the IKEA furniture feels sturdy. Ideally, ...
