If the guide roller is under the cab, push the control lever/pedal to move machine forward. Fig. 2-52A sign for travel direction can be found on internal side of undercarriage.

So, my boat came with a D400 wind generator. I have a dedicated Amp meter, and it performs pretty close to the factory specs. In other words, it's crap.

Take off the cast tie on the top of the 2 guide rods. Loosen the 2 square head bolts and soak in oil, and tap under it. It comes off the top of the guide rods. Where the one (longer) guide rod ...
