How much will SMUD charge per kilowatt hour?

SMUD's rate is projected to increase 5.6% this year, averaging \$0.1755 per kilowatt hour. Even with the additional planned hikes, residential rates will remain roughly 50% lower than PG& E's, which is charging \$0.383 per kilowatt hour, according to SMUD.

Is SMUD a fixed rate?

Eligible customers can switch to a fixed rate price that doesn't change throughout the year. The fixed rate on average is roughly 4% higher than the "time-of-day rate," according to the utility. What are SMUD's non-summer 'time-of-day' rates?
